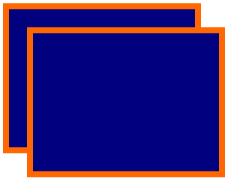

### **C. Lloyd Luckhoo remembered with Memorial Services and Special Session of the Supreme Court (Court of Appeal and High Court) in Antigua and Barbuda**

On July 10<sup>th</sup> a memorial service was held at the St John's Anglican Cathedral, for C. Lloyd Luckhoo, who died in Guyana on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2002. The family of Lloyd was in attendance as was a contingent from the Antigua & Barbuda Bar. Lloyd worked in Antigua & Barbuda as one of the leading silks since 1984 up to about two years ago, when he retired.

On 5<sup>th</sup> June 2002 the Court of Appeal and the High Court convened a special session to pay tribute to Lloyd. The Court was addressed by Honourable Attorney-General Gertel Thom; Sydney P. Christian, Q.C.; Gerald O. Watt, Q.C.; Clare K. Roberts, President of the Antigua & Barbuda Bar Association; Mr Justice Satrohan Singh, Court of Appeal judge and Hon. Chief Justice, Sir Dennis Byron.

Lloyd Luckhoo was born in Guyana on 11<sup>th</sup> August 1918. He became QC in 1947 but was probably the least well known of the Famous Luckhoo Brothers: Lionel, Edward ("E.V") and Lloyd. He survived Sir Lionel of Guinness Book of Records fame, and Sir Edward. Lloyd was a well-known horse owner and horse-racing commentator.
