CARRICULUM VITAE OF STANLEY KENDRICK JOHN ESQ

Stanley Kendrick John was born at Calliaqua, St Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) on 1st June 1951.

He was educated at the St. Vincent Grammar School then the Faculty of Laws at University College London, where he graduated in 1976 with the LLB (Hons) and entered the Inns of Courts School of Law from where he was admitted to the degree of Utter Barrister at Gray's Inn, London in July 1977. He subsequently became a pupil in the law chambers headed by Sir Louis Blom-Cooper QC at Queen Elizabeth Buildings in the Temple. He returned to SVG in 1978 and was admitted to practice law before the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court.

In addition to being a relatively busy lawyer Mr. John carried out various civic and public life responsibilities in SVG over the years, among these, he was a member of the St Vincent Lions Club and held various offices in this organization, including those of Secretary and President respectively.

He also served as a Government Senator in the House of Assembly during 1983 and as an Opposition Senator from 1984 to 1989. He was a candidate for elections as a Representative in the House of Assembly in General Elections between 1989 and 2001 and was elected as the representative for East St George in the 1998. He served at various times as Editor of The Star newspaper and as Public Relations Officer of the St. Vincent and the Grenadines Labour Party (SVGLP) and from 1992 to 1994 as the Political Leader.

Since 2001 Mr. John has been engaged primarily in practice as a lawyer, with ample experience in litigating and advising on a wide range of legal matters including constitutional and administrative law, commercial law, employment law, international banking and financing, international trade and maritime law. Since 1979 he has represented various foreign government agencies, banks, insurance companies, trusts and other domestic and international companies, in relation to matters pertaining to the laws of SVG.

Mr. John is married to Maureen John nee Providence. They have two sons; R. Akin. S John Esq. who is a practicing Barrister & Solicitor with his father at Elizabeth Law Chambers and Carlton Stanley K John 25 years, who is a graduate IT software developer in the USA.
